1. Greg provided a brief status of the Winter Emergency Season at the Shelter
 2. Greg and the Boulder Police Department reached out to the management of the Violet on Broadway apartments to discuss issues and concerns, including managing trespassing problems.
 3. Greg provided an explanation and update to the new intake process for emergency sheltering. The process has provided several benefits including smoother intake, reduction of stress, and better planning for the Boulder Shelter and clients.
 4. Liz talked about her concerns with the group of apparently homeless individuals at the corner of Broadway and US 36. There were no specific problems and little need for action.
 5. Mark will send the link to previous NSAG meeting minutes to Liz
 6. The services of the Resource Center have been dialed back at the Boulder Shelter to 1 day/week (Monday) because of lower demand.
 7. There was a general discussion on the low attendance of the NSAG meetings and the need to recruit new members from the community. One idea was to go from monthly meetings to quarterly meetings or more often as needed for specific activities. No action was taken although it is something we need to be thinking about.
